Hello everybody and welcome to your latest good news.

There have been numerous discussions lately and a number of decisions have been taken regarding the ranges and competitions thereon.

In this letter you will find a list of competitions for Bulford 'E' and Old Sarum for the whole year.

The way this will work is as follows.

As you will know there will likely be cancellations for the Bulford ranges during the year.

In such a case the comp. for that date will be moved to the bottom of the list even though it may then have to be held the following year.

Thus, for example, if the 15<sup>th</sup> May should be cancelled, R4 and R6, this will go to the bottom of the list and the range for 25<sup>th</sup> June will remain R8 and R7.

This method will save chopping and changing the ranges all the time and having to send out mails and make phone calls all the time and confusing everyone.

The ranges for Old Sarum should not be affected in any way so they will stand as such.

Ken B has come up with a new list of competitions designated 'Core' and 'Additional' agreed by Chris, Ian and myself, from which you will see a 'Core' competition as the main one for each range and an 'Additional' added which will be shot for if time permits.

The full list of the new competitions appears in this letter which you will be able to keep separate and safe so that you will always have the information to hand and will never be in doubt as to what is happening on any day.

Bulford Range opens at 0800 hrs so this should allow plenty of time to get set up for the competitions to start by 0930 at the very latest.

Firers will be accompanied by a scorer during the competition who will do the scoring as indicated by the butt's marker thus saving a lot of time in marking and patching up.

The competition sheets will replace sheets 8, 9 and 10 in your Rules and Regulations.
